### Experience

Renato Guerrieri, lawyer, mainly concentrates his activities in the Litigation and Antitrust Departments.

His practice includes advising in relation to infrastructure projects including PPP contracts, expropriations, easements, and litigation proceedings before the Administrative Litigation Court, as well as other aspects of administrative, trade and communications law.

He also participates in the Antitrust Department, advising clients in their commercial strategies from an antitrust perspective; in the assessment and defense within administrative and jurisdictional proceedings in relation to anticompetitive practices, collusion, abuse of dominance and unfair competition; in relation to competition compliance and advocacy; and in merger control proceedings. He participates in periodical training courses, as well in drafting protocols and guidelines, and in the performance of audits and dawn-raids simulations. He has advised the Antitrust Authority in projects of legislation review.

He has served as Professor in Antitrust Law at Universidad Católica del Uruguay. He is currently concluding the LL.M. Master in Law of Universidad de Montevideo.
