Leonardo Slinger, lawyer, mainly concentrates his activities in the Labor and Litigation Departments. He is Assistant Professor of Labor Law at Universidad de la República (UdelaR), Universidad Católica, and Universidad de Montevideo. His practice includes advising on labor matters, companies' reorganizations, as well as negotiations with unions in conflictive collective cases and social security issues. Specialist in labor law, he also handles labor, civil and commercial litigation. He is the coordinator of the Litigation Department. Member of Asociación Uruguaya de Derecho del Trabajo.

Leonardo actively participates in diverse pro-bono projects, including those related to education, childhood and people with disabilities.
