In her most recent experience, Lucía has participated in the Arbitration Diploma organized by the University of Montevideo, and the Specialized Arbitration Course organized by the Institution ARBANZA.

Additionally, she has been selected in April 2021 as a member of the Drafting Committee of the case problem for the investment arbitration competition Foreign Direct Investment Arbitration Moot, to be held in November 2022.

In the frame of those competitions, she has participated in several premoots, being the runner up in the premooc organized by the law firm Mannheimer Swartling of Stockholm, and the first place and an honorable mention as an oralist in the premooc organized by the law firm Tozzini Freire of San Pablo. She has also participated in other premoocs organized in Curitiba, Hamburg, and Heidelberg.

After graduating Law School, she became a coach of the team of the University and remains doing so up to this date.

As a team coach, she participated in the Foreign Direct Investment Arbitration Moot, 15th Edition, in which the team was among the Top 32 teams, among more than 100 participants. The team also participated in the Willem C. Vis International Commercial Arbitration Moot, in which Lucía also intervened as an arbitrator for general rounds. The team participated in a premooc organized by the Centro de Arbitraje y Mediación de Santiago de Chile, in which was the prevailing team. The team participated in other premoocs organized by the University Carlos III of Madrid, the University of Bigli of Istanbul, and the Permanent Court of Arbitration of Buenos Aires, in which she also participated as an arbitrator.
